
explored, developed, and published this document.





STARS, the Sustainability Tracking, Assessment & Rating System, is a rigorous evaluation of sustainability in all aspects of higher education.








Our most recent College cafeteria and food services area waste audit results reflect the proportion of waste to landfill and recyclables captured or misdirected to landfill. Audit was completed January 9-10, 2020 by Best Service Pros.



Frost Campus has completed a waste audit for the past three years through Waste Collections of Canada. This audit will continue to track the division of waste collected from Frost Campus as we explore alternative waste solutions. This ongoing waste audit is not yet available for Haliburton Campus.


